ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS FOR A HEERF GRANT:

• Students must be registered and attending at Midwestern University for the quarter they receive the award.

Award amounts will be based on student need as determined by the Student Financial Services Office.

Applicants will be contacted within ten to fifteen business days after submitting their application.

As the grant draws on a limited pool of funds, Midwestern cannot guarantee the availability of funds for assistance.
