- Hands-on live animal contact and clinical skills training begin in the first year and continue throughout the four-year program
- During clinical training, students rotate through a variety of diverse veterinary care experiences, both on campus and at external sites
- Campus buildings, including Cactus Wren Hall, the Companion Animal Clinic, the Large Animal Clinic, and the Diagnostic Pathology Center, are designed specifically for CVM students and offer state-of-the-art training

Admission Requirements

- 1. A minimum cumulative GPA and science GPA of 3.00 on a 4.00
- 2. Three letters of recommendation (one must be from a veterinarian)
- 3. Completion of a minimum of 240 hours (6 weeks) of veterinary, health sciences, animal or biomedical research experience
