

ECONOMIC IMPACT



Midwestern University had a substantial economic impact on the DuPage County economy in fiscal year 2019.

\$495.2 Million Overall Impact

Midwestern University is committed to educating healthcare professionals and is proud to be one of the region's significant economic engines. Recently, the University commissioned a comprehensive, independent analysis by Applied Economics, a specialized economics consulting firm, to determine its current and ongoing *financial impact:*

\$80.1 MILLION IN DIRECT PAYROLL AND 670 JOBS The University provides quality, good-paying jobs to Illinois residents. **\$14.1** MILLION IN STATE AND LOCAL TAXES Midwestern indirectly generates property, sales, and personal income tax revenues. **\$28** MILLION

IN LOCAL Vendor Spending

The University is an important purchaser of local supplies and services.

Through their spending, Midwestern students supported 1,200 jobs and created \$52.6 million in labor income at local businesses.

\$83.5 MILLION IN CONSTRUCTION Spending

Midwestern will spend \$83.5 million in construction expenditures from 2019 to 2027. The construction activity will create an economic impact of approximately \$127.4 million in DuPage County over the next nine years, along with supporting about 640 jobs and \$45.5 million in total labor income in the county.



Expanding Knowledge

At Midwestern University, research is considered a vital ingredient for excellent teaching. It is our goal, as a healthcare university, to not only disseminate knowledge, but to create new knowledge and to foster life-long learning in our students. To that end, the University supported research by awarding 44 student fellowships, and 24 support positions *at a total cost of \$1.97 million fiscal year 2019.*
