VSP Global Diversity Admissions Scholarship

Description

The VSP Global Diversity Admissions Scholarship is awarded to optometry students of color who have been accepted at either the Chicago College of Optometry (CCO) or Arizona College of Optometry (AZCOPT). One \$10,000 scholarship will be awarded per year, alternating between CCO and AZCOPT. However, for the 22-23 scholarship cycle there will be an award for each campus in the amount of \$10,000.00.

Students must be an underrepresented minority as defined by the Health Resources and Services Administration (HRSA). Students must matriculate in the year in which the scholarship is available for that program/campus.

Optometry

Eligibility Criteria:

- Deposited, incoming Optometry student for matriculation year in which funds are available for that program
- Student is an **underrrepresented minority** (as defined by HRSA), falling into one or more of the following categories:
 - American Indian or Alaska Native: A person having origins in any of the original peoples of North America, and who maintains cultural identification through tribal affiliation or community recognition
 - **Black or African American**: A person having origins in any of the black racial groups of Africa
 - **Hispanic or Latino**: A person of Mexican, Puerto Rican, Cuban, Central or South American, or other Spanish culture or origin without regard to race

• Native Hawaiian or Other Pacific Islander: A person having origins in any of the original peoples of Hawaii, Guam, Samoa, or other Pacific Islands

Minimum GPA

Criteria/Requirements

Funds will be awarded on a competitive basis to eligible student applicants based on the following criteria:

- · Past academic performance/GPA
- Essay: Submit a 200-word or less essay demonstrating commitment to diversity through leadership roles, past academic projects/research, participation in working with underrepresented groups, employment, and/or community service activities
- Preference will be given to first-generation college students
- Demonstrated financial need. Students must have completed the Financial Aid application process so that financial need can be evaluated.
